Cure for: The entire plant is used in various medical preparation. Each part has a different therapeutic value like Root bark is antiperiodic, astringent, tonic, Bark of tree is astringent, antiperiodic, antiviral, bitter, tonic, vermifuge, Leaves are antiviral, discutient, emmenagogue, Flowers are stimulant, stomachic, tonic, Fruit are anthelmintic, purgative, emollient, Juice are anthelmintic, Oil extracted from the nut is antiseptic, insecticide, local stimulant. Neem is one of the best known bitter tonic that helps detoxification and improves immune system.

It has anti-viral and anti-bacterial properties and work excellently in skin disorders and liver problems. The Neem formulations are useful in arthritis, blood - purifies and detoxifies, bronchitis, cough, diabetes, drowsiness, eczema, fever, jaundice, leukorrhea, malaria, nausea, obesity, parasites, rheumatism, skin diseases, syphilis, thirst, tumors, vomiting, worms, inflammatory and febrile diseases.
